WATER-MINING Marketplace Platform A User Guide



FAQs

What is the purpose of the platform?

The WATER-MINING platform aims to link industries, desalination plants, raw material market suppliers, technology providers, and waste heat providers who are interested in saline wastewater management and the recovery or use minerals and water.

How does the matching algorithm work?

For a match to take place the platform considers 4 variables, depending on the role.

EWC (European Waste Catalogue):

The algorithm considers the EWC code associated with the user's products or services. This code categorises waste and recovered materials, ensuring that matches are made based on compatibility and relevance within the waste management industry.

Quality: Quality criteria are assessed to ensure that the products or services offered by one user meet the standards and requirements of the other.

Quantity: The algorithm evaluates the quantity of products or services available from one user and matches it with the demand or requirements of the other user. This helps optimise resource utilisation and ensures that matches are made based on supply and demand dynamics.

Distance: The distance between users is considered to facilitate efficient logistics and minimise transportation costs. The algorithm takes into account geographical proximity to identify matches that are feasible and cost-effective.

What information do I need to provide to create a profile?

You first need to set your username & password. Then you need to provide the location of your entity. Lastly, you need to provide your NACE code that classifies your industry.

What features are available for communicating with other users?

You can communicate to any user in the platform by searching for a role. Through the search tab you can select the role you are looking for. In the list of results that will come up, you can message users by clicking on the mail button.

Through the Messages tab you can send your message to the desired receiver by selecting them through the "to" drop down list.

Through the Suggested Matches tab, you can send direct message to any of your matches, by clicking on the email button.

Is there a limit to the number of matches I can have?

No, you can have as many as you want.
